

SEEDING STATE TOURNAMENT SOCCER

This seeding process was adopted by ASAA in 2003. It has been modified twice---the most recent being 2009, when the coaches requested that the four conference champions receive the top four seeds. The process that will be used is listed below. Coaches are responsible for submitting the results of all games played or checking the posting on the asaa.org soccer page.

Criteria used for seeding:

- 1. Varsity Win-Loss Record (3 points win, 1 point tie)**
(only games played with Alaskan teams count)
---Divided by number of games played
---Multiplied by factor of 10
- 2. Strength of Schedule defined as follows:**
---Transcribe opponents overall records into points.
---Add Points up.
---Divide by number of games played in season.
(each game played against team will count separately)
- 3. Results of Conference Tournament**
5 points for first place (or if no tournament is held)
3 points for second place
1 point for third place

At this point, the four conference champions will be ranked, based on the total points of the first three criteria. Then the following criteria will be considered if necessary.

- 4 Head to head Record**
---if tied, less amount of goals scored against will break it.
- 5. Record against common opponents during the season.**

Then the other four teams will be ranked and seeded following the same criteria for the last four bracket positions.
