

Softball Tie Breaker Rule

Adopted by ASAA

If, after the completion of seven (7) innings of play, the score is tied, the following tie-breaker rule will be played to determine a winning team.

- A. Starting with the top of the eighth inning, and each half inning thereafter, the offensive team shall begin its turn at bat with the player who is scheduled to bat last in that respective half inning being placed on second base (if the number five batter is the lead off batter, the number four batter in the line up will be placed on second base. A substitute may be inserted for the runner).
